Before ,During, and After the Round Etiquette

Players will learn what to do and what not to do when it is not their shot during the round. The players will learn the proper place to stand as well as when and where to walk while a playing partner is taking their shot. How to maintain the course through proper ball mark repair, bunker raking, and divot replacement will also be covered. Players will be taught tricks on how to make an impression on the golf course staff that will help them and other junior golfers in the future.
